## Official Letter to all Secretaries of Govt. of India and Chief Secretaries in States

Sir/ Madam,

This has reference to Secretary DST's D.O. Letter No. 2/9/9/2022/NSDI dated 30/09/2022 to the Secretaries of the concerned Ministries, Heads of Institutions and Chief Secretaries of the States implementing the State SDI Data Nodes regarding implementation of the Interim Data Sharing Framework (IDSF).

In this connection, it may please be noted that the implementation of IDSF was briefly reported in the last meeting of the GDPDC held in DST, Technology Bhawan on 27.04.2023 under the chairmanship of Shri RS Sharma IAS (Retd.), Former Secretary to Government of India, MeitY. Appreciating the requirement of IDSF implementation, GDPDC felt that there has been a need to assess the Data Sharing Readiness of each of the Partnering Agencies in order to draw up suitable strategies for gradually migrating from the interim data sharing framework to a state-of-the-art framework in the quickest possible time-frame in line with the vision and goals of the National Geospatial Policy 2022. It has therefore been decided that each of the Partnering Agencies may consider providing the required information for making an assessment of the current state of readiness of on-line geospatial data sharing of the organisation by filling up the Table attached below.

It is thus requested that you may please share with us the required information in the attached Table for further analysis and follow up.
